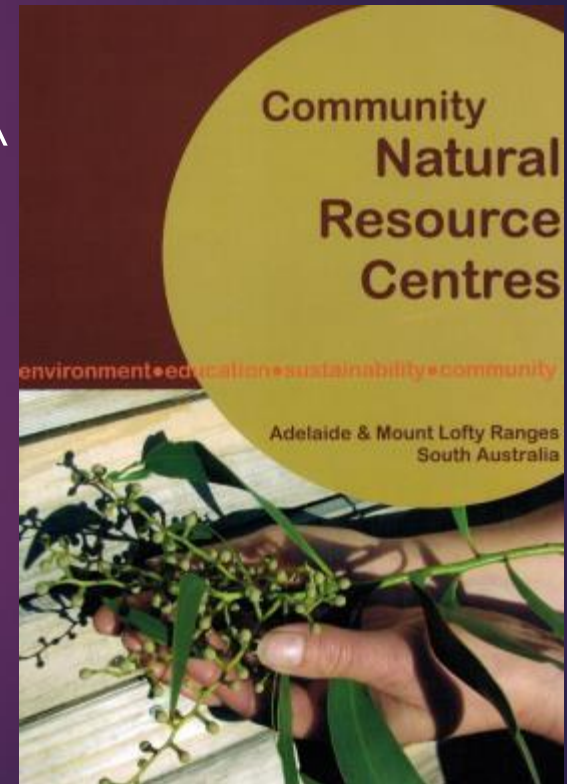

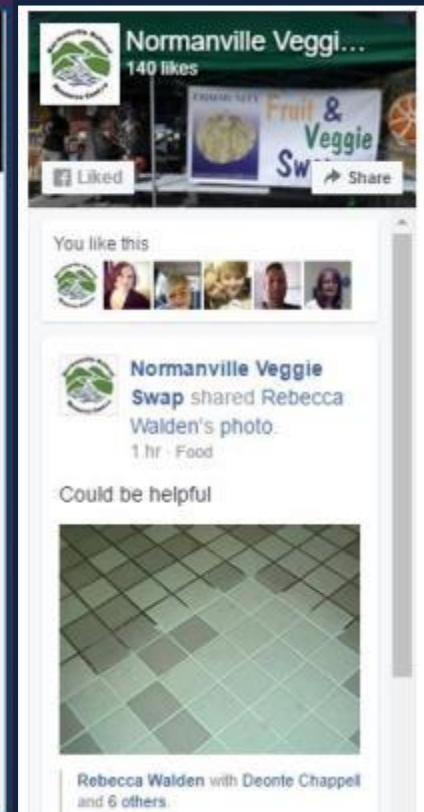
# NATIVE COTTAGE GARDEN

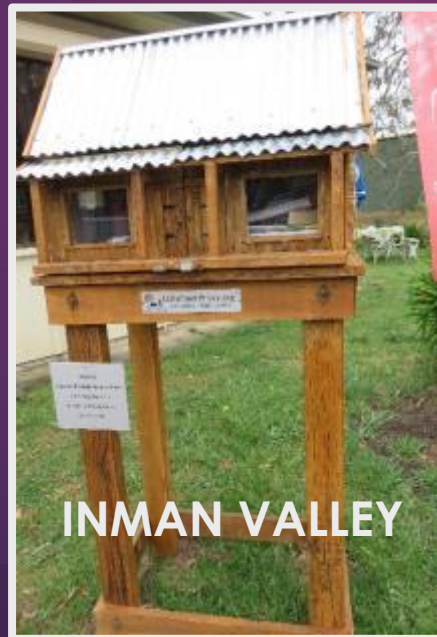

ONCE PRODUCING FRUIT THE LOCAL COMMUNITY WILL BE ABLE TO HELP THEMSELVES.

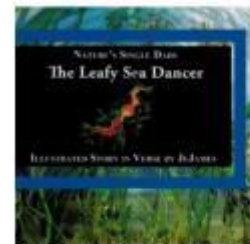

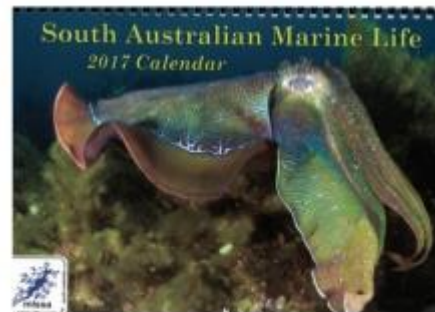
